In connection with the above referenced contract, we hereby notify and request that you publish in the next issue of "Notice to Mariners" an alert to those using the locations identified on the chart of St. Lucie Inlet.

**Operation:** Dredge "ALASKA" will be dredging at the following Locations:  
Entrance Channel to St. Lucie Inlet

Ancillary Equipment includes: Dredge, Booster Pumping Station, Anchor Barge, Tugs,  
Derrick barge & floating pipeline.

Be aware of submerged pipeline in the area.

**Location:** Chart # 11474, Approx 27.10°N 80.09°W

**Request:** "Mariners are urged to contact Dredge Alaska, Tug Franklin, or Tug Little Debbie, prior to transiting area. There will be a very shallow submerged pipeline outside channel on the south side. Transiting this area will be extremely hazardous"

**Duration:** Beginning February 02, 2007 to February 15, 2007

**Quantity:** 100,000 c.y.

The Dredge "ALASKA", "TUG FRANKLIN" and "TUG LITTLE DEBBIE", can be contacted on VHF Ch 13 & 16. All equipment will be manned and lit in accordance with U.S. Coast Guard Regulations.
